


PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Cnam-Enjmin is a leading public Higher Education and Research Institution which trains students for all professions related to video game development. Cnam (Conservatoire national des arts et métiers), our umbrella institution, has a long history providing scientific, cultural and professional lifelong education. We boast numerous partnerships with universities, research laboratories and key industry players both in France and internationally. Known as the "Balcony to Southwestern France", the town is found in the Charente Department, in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Region.

Angoulême is known as the world capital for all things **comic strips**, which has led to it being recognised as a **UNESCO Creative Town** in the literature category.

IF YOU ARRIVE BY TRAIN

Angoulême has train links with the following main stations:

- Bordeaux Saint-Jean (≈ 40 mins)
- Paris Montparnasse (≈ 2 hours 15 mins)
- Charles de Gaulle 2 TGV Airport [outside of Paris] (≈ 3 hours)
- Massy TGV [Parisian suburbs] (≈ 2 hours 10 mins)
- Marne-la-Vallée Chessy [Parisian suburbs] (≈ 2 hours 50 mins)
- Strasbourg (≈ 5 hours 20 mins)
- Lille Flandres (≈ 4 hours 30 mins)



Paris Charles de Gaulle (Roissy CDG) Airport

Without leaving the airport building, the train station is located on the first floor of Terminal 2.

There are several direct trains every day between the airport and Angoulême, and the journey takes around 3 hours.

Paris Orly (ORY) Airport

You will have to make your way to either Paris Montparnasse station or Massy TGV station by taxi, Uber or public transport.

Public transport from Paris Orly Airport to Paris Montparnasse station:

- Journey: Take metro line 14 to Maison Blanche, then line 7 to Place d'Italie, and finally line 6 to Montparnasse-Bienvenue
- Duration: Around 45 mins
- Cost: €13 ("Paris Région Airports tickets | RATP")

There are several direct trains every day between Paris Montparnasse station and Angoulême, and the journey takes around 2 hours 15 mins.

Public transport from Paris Orly Airport to Massy TGV station:

- Journey: Take the Orlyval metro to Antony, then the RER B to Massy Palaiseau
- Duration: Around 30 mins
- Cost: €13 ("Paris Région Airports tickets | RATP")

There are several direct trains every day between Massy TGV station and Angoulême, and the journey takes around 2 hours 10 mins.

Bordeaux-Mérignac (BOD) Airport

You will have to make your way to Bordeaux Saint-Jean station by taxi, Uber or public transport.


Public transport from Bordeaux airport to Bordeaux Saint-Jean station:

- Journey: Direct shuttle bus Airport Station
- Duration: Around 30 mins
- Cost: €10 on board, €8 online one way, €14.40 online return

There are several direct trains every day between Bordeaux Saint-Jean station and Angoulême, and the journey takes around 40 mins.



- By taxi: Less than 5 mins
- By public transport: Around 10 to 15 mins
 - o Option 1: Bus line 6 to La Cité
 - o Option 2: Bus line 5 to Le Nil
 - o Cost of a ticket on board €2, cost of a ticket online €1.50
- By foot: Around 20 mins (distance: 1.5km)







- By foot: Around 14 mins (1.1km)








How to get to Cnam-Enjmin from the hotel

Visit Cognac

The town of Cognac is known for its famous eau-de-vie (brandy) which shares the same name, but it is also where François ler, King of France from 1515 to 1547, was born.

We recommend that you take a stroll around the town centre and then visit a maison de cognac (cognac distillery) for a visit around the premises and a cognac tasting session.



How to get to Cognac: 40 mins by train (line L16) from Angoulême (around €25 return)



Visit a *maison de cognac*: <u>Hennessy</u> offers several options

- Hennessy Introduction: Visit lasts 1 hour 30 mins, go behind the scenes on how they make cognac + tasting included. €25 per person.
- Hennessy Immersive Introduction:
 Visit lasts 2 hours, go behind the
 scenes on how they make cognac +
 tasting included, as well as an
 immersive VR experience.

Visit the <u>Fondation d'entreprise Martell</u>

Exhibitions, residencies and conferences, all with a focus on living things

- Free entry: Access to exhibitions, residencies and conferences is free. However, there may be a fee for some events, but this is clearly stated on their website.
- Around 2 hours (permanent and temporary exhibitions)
