Subject: Awarding Procedure of Mobility Grants for Cnam-Enjmin Students in collaboration with the DAEI (European and International Affairs Management, *Direction des affaires européennes et internationales*) at Cnam

1. Cnam-Enjmin Courses Concerned

- To date, the **Master's degree in Video Games and Digital Interactive Media (JMIN)** is the only degree course concerned by students going on mobility periods that are partially financed by mobility grants from the DAEI at Cnam.
- To date, the 3 bachelor's degrees (in Computer Science for Video Games, in Digital Arts for Video Games and Multimedia and in Game Design) are not concerned by mobility programmes given the diplomas' apprenticeship status.
- The Engineering degree in Computer Science and Multimedia is connected to Cnam Nouvelle-Aquitaine, which equally looks after and handles mobility grants.
- The Post-Master's degree in Designing of Interactive Experiences is in partnership with the GOBELIS Paris School, which equally looks after and handles mobility grants.

2. Mobility for Studies

To date, Cnam-Enjmin has **2 dual-degree programmes** open to students on the JMIN Master's degree:

- Dual-degree with **Cologne Game Lab (CGL) - TH Köln in Germany**, diploma involved [M.A. Digital Games](#). This programme has an average of two participants per year, with a maximum of three due to the specific nature of the master's programme (see Appendix 1.a).
- Dual-degree with **NAD-UQAC School in Canada**, diploma involved [DESS en design de jeu vidéo narratif](#) (DESS diploma in Narrative Video Game Design). This programme has an average of two participants per year, with a maximum of three due to the specific nature of the master's programme (see Appendix 1.b).

Study mobility grants are awarded based on **criteria defined by Cnam-Enjmin** at the DAEI's request. As part of this framework, the Cnam-Enjmin management team has decided to introduce a **pedagogical preselection** with the two dual-degree programmes.

For the dual-degree with CGL, the following documents must be provided by Cnam-Enjmin candidates:

- CV with a link to their portfolio
- Motivation letter
- Transcript of Marks for the previous semester
- One-page describing the envisaged MA Thesis subject

For the dual-degree with NAD-UQAC, the following documents must be provided by Cnam-Enjmin candidates:

- CV with a link to their portfolio
- Motivation letter
- Transcript of Marks for current or previous higher educational studies

To date, no other study mobility programmes are available for Cnam-Enjmin students. Cnam-Enjmin does not have any new projects with other partners available in the short term.

3. Internship Mobility

As part of their **mandatory professional internship** (Module Code UA333K, 22 ECTS), students on the JMIN Master's degree have the opportunity to complete their internship abroad. The number of students going abroad varies each year, but an average of 3 to 4 participants per year has been observed (see Appendix 1.c).

Given the low number of departures observed for internships abroad, the Cnam-Enjmin management team has decided not to implement specific selection criteria.

4. Method of Awarding Grants in collaboration with the DAEI

Each academic year, Cnam-Enjmin completes a table entitled "Estimation of mobility grant requirements" ("*Estimation des besoins en bourses de mobilité*") at the DAEI's request. Cnam-Enjmin updates the figures based on the number of students completing a mobility period over the previous years. The school indicates whether the mobility was completed in Europe or outside Europe, whether it was a study or work mobility, and information about Erasmus+ and the AMI grant (International Mobility Grant).

For each new application, and after reviewing the application according to the criteria established above, Cnam-Enjmin sends the DAEI its students' grant applications in accordance with the methodology established by the DAEI.
